For your information

Our camps are conducted by experienced staff. Every effort will be taken in looking after your child's welfare. No child is allowed to leave Camp except under supervision and the director's permission.

Our aim is that your child comes away with lasting memories of what they have experienced, explored and enjoyed at our camp. We will be focusing on building strong, healthy relationships with each other and our group leaders. We have a week packed full of activities, action and fun.

Due to heavy demand and limited numbers it is essential you **send the application form and registration fee as soon as possible. Acceptance of all registrations will be at the discretion of the Director. You will be notified whether or not your application has been successful.**

No phone bookings are accepted.

Discipline: Campers are only accepted on the condition that they come under the normal discipline of CBM Camps. We use a graduated system of discipline.

1. Time Out
2. Meeting with Director or staff member
3. Sent Home (after discussion with parents) No refund or fees will be issued.

Where are we? Our beautiful campsite is situated on the bush-clad slopes of Mt Karioi and has panoramic views of the Tasman Sea and beach. The camp is 6 km beyond Raglan at 578 Wainui Road on the way to Whale Bay.

Friends: Your child will be grouped according to age in the care of a senior leader. If your child wishes to be in the same group as their friends, please specify their friend's name on the registration form. We will endeavor to accommodate their request. **(limit 2)** as long as the children are of similar age.

Contacting your child: If you wish to contact your child, please feel free to write, email or fax them. Please note however that we do not have the facilities for campers to reply to emails or faxes or to receive phone calls except in emergencies.

SURVIVAL CAMP INFORMATION

Name all Clothes - Please ensure all clothes and belongings are clearly named. When collecting young people at the end of camp, please check the lost property before you leave. All lost property remains at the camp for one term only.

Pocket Money - A well-stocked Canteen is available. We recommend each child bring between \$12 - \$15. You may pay this online or bring it with you to hand on arrival at camp.

CAMP FEES & BUS INFO

Please refer to the specific camp fees & bus info PDF.

Registration Fees are payable at the rate of \$50.00 per camper on all bookings and is part of the full fee.

Balance of Fees must be paid 7 days prior to the commencing date of Camp.

We cannot undertake to hold bookings which are not confirmed by payment of balance of fees.

Refund of Fees (except registration) will be made if the camper is unable to attend, provided that 7 days' notice is given prior to the start of camp. Any other refunds are at the discretion of the Camp Director. Please Note: Any young person leaving camp early is not eligible for any refund.

Arrival / Departure Times: Camp officially **opens** at 3 **pm** in the afternoon and **closes at 9 am** on the last day of camp. Please collect your children as soon as possible after this time and no later than **11 am**.

Transport: If you indicate that your young person will be travelling by Intercity Transport, it is up to you to book these tickets through Intercity. Details of the services and times are on the camp fees & bus info PDF.

NB: A Camp Bus will run between Hamilton and Raglan return. Details and prices are on the fee & bus info PDF. Please indicate if you want to use this service.

Bus fares are not included in camp fees.

We accept a limited number of young people 16yrs of age and over to assist at camp as Junior Leaders.

WHAT TO BRING CHECKLIST

THE ESSENTIALS — Tick off items as you pack them...

- A packet of sweet biscuits per camper (Please **no biscuits containing peanuts** due to peanut allergies) (*Hand in at registration*)
- Warm sleeping bag – or sheets and blankets – we may sleep out
- Extra blankets – NB: Bed wetters must bring extra bedding i.e. 2 sleeping bags

- A pillow (*camp pillows are available if you bring a pillow slip*)
- Toilet gear
- Plastic Bag for wet, dirty clothes
- 3-4 towels
- Old shoes (*at least 2 pairs*)
- Jacket
- Sun hat
- Sun cream
- Torch
- Bible
- Lots of warm clothes for the week (*include old clothes*)
- Togs (*NB: If ear plugs or bathing cap is required, please hand in to office on arrival*)
- Wetsuit (*not essential, but helpful if you own one!*)
- Rash Vest for Public Pool Swimming (*girls*)
- Lunchbox
- Drink bottle
- Day backpack
- Pencil, pad & envelopes (*stamped & addressed*)
- Sense of humour!
- Clothing for Paint Ball
 - Old jeans or long pants
 - A sweatshirt you don't mind getting paint on
 - Old sneakers/sandshoes
 - Black plastic rubbish bag for your paint marked clothes. We will provide the paintball guns, masks and ammo.

PLEASE DO NOT BRING

Cutlery & crockery – as they are provided.

Knives, matches, chewing gum, MP3 players, cell phones, any electronic devices or other valuables as they are not allowed.

PLEASE NAME ALL BELONGINGS
